The modern guide to removing your tattoo

If you're considering tattoo removal, this guide will help you understand the process. Since laser tattoo removal is a significant medical procedure, it's essential to know who will treat you and what laser technology is being used. To save you time and effort, we have answered the most important questions about tattoo removal, focusing on laser technology.









How does laser tattoo removal work?

Laser tattoo removal uses a laser to break up the tattoo pigment into smaller particles, which are then flushed out through the body's immune system over time. Treatments are spaced 4 to 8 weeks apart, allowing your body time to heal and remove the ink. As the treatments progress, the tattoo gradually fades and, with enough sessions, eventually disappears.

Some clinics may claim that the laser type doesn't matter, but that's false. Clinics using outdated lasers may require 10 to 20 sessions to remove a tattoo and they use lasers relying on heat, and that heat can be painful. With the Candela Picoway Laser, treatments are cut in half! This is because the Picoway laser uses acoustic energy that works faster and more effectively, breaking up ink particles into smaller pieces for quicker elimination. The "Pico" technology refers to laser energy being delivered in trillionths of a second, offering quicker results and lower risk of scarring.





How effective is laser tattoo removal?

Laser tattoo removal is widely considered the gold standard due to its safety and effectiveness. Most tattoos can be removed completely with a series of treatments. The speed and success depend on the tattoo's characteristics:

\rightarrow Black, dark blue, and red

tattoos are easiest to remove.

\rightarrow **Green and teal**

inks are harder but can be significantly faded or removed.

Yellow and purple

inks are the most resistant but can still be faded or removed.





How long will it take to remove?

Removal time varies depending on multiple factors:

Skin Colour

Lighter skin makes removal faster.

Tattoo Location

Near the heart heal faster due to better circulation.

Ink Density

Denser tattoos need more treatments.

Tattoo Colour

Blue, and red are easiest; other colours require more sessions.

Amateur vs. Professional Ink

Amateur tattoos are typically easier to remove.



Older tattoos are easier to remove.

Tattoos in black ink on lighter skin are easier to remove, while recent tattoos or brightly coloured ones may take longer. Tattoos typically need between 4 and 10 treatments spaced 6 weeks apart.

How long does each treatment take?

The treatment time depends on the size of the tattoo. Smaller tattoos may take under a minute, while large tattoos (like sleeves) can take up to an hour.



Does it hurt?

Laser tattoo removal is typically not painful. Some patients find it uncomfortable, but we use an ice air chiller on all our patients to minimise any discomfort. If necessary, numbing cream can be used for more extensive treatments.

After the treatment, the skin feels like a mild sunburn for a few days.

Side effects can include redness, swelling, blistering, and scabbing but they generally resolve fully within a week. After the treatment the area must be kept clean and protected to avoid infection. The most serious possible side effect is hypopigmentation, which lightens the treated skin, especially in darker skin tones. Choosing an experienced clinic with the PicoWay laser will help minimise this risk.






How much does it cost?

Tattoo removal is more affordable than many expect, especially since our Picoway laser reduces the number of sessions required. What to expect at your first treatment.

- Arrive at the clinic and sit down with our clinician for 10 minutes to review your tattoo and the treatment plan.
- Then we clean the area to be treated. We can administer some numbing cream at that point if you would like. All done in a couple of minutes.
- >> Then we all put on the laser safety googles and we give you the hose from the icy air machine and ask you to point it at the tattoo. This helps to numb the skin and minimise any discomfort.
- Then a quick zap test from the laser to let you get accustomed to the feeling of the laser on your skin. This also allows us to see how your skin reacts to the laser and then modify the treatment settings.
- And then we laser your tattoo by running the laser over your skin. Treatment time can be as little as 30 seconds or 30minutes depending on the size of your tattoo.
- >> Our clinician then adds a dressing to the treated area and we discuss how to look after the area for the next few days.
- >> And finally, we book your next appointment in.
- >> Your first appointment will typically be 30minutes but your treatments after that may be a short as 15 minutes.
- So it really is easy and simple to get done. Lie back and relax and let the experts get on with reclaiming your skin.




